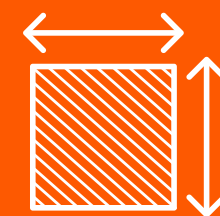

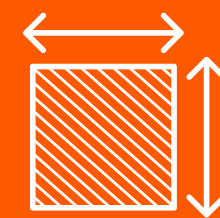

ITINERARY

Day 01. Arrival

Upon arrival at Heydar Aliyev International Airport, a representative from our company will meet and transfer you to the hotel for check-in. In the evening, you can enjoy a walk along Baku Corniche, experiencing the charm of the city's night ambiance. Return to the hotel for some free time, or relax (optional).

Day 02. Baku City Tour

After breakfast at the hotel, the driver will take you to Highland Park, offering a stunning view of Baku city. Next, you'll visit the Old City and the Maiden Tower, a UNESCO World Cultural Heritage site. We'll then head to the Flame Towers, a modern symbol of Baku, and explore its museum, which tells the story of the city's development. From the top floor, enjoy a panoramic view of Baku and the Caspian Sea. The tour continues with a visit to Shirvanshah Palace, dating back to the 15th century. After lunch, we will visit the Carpet Museum, home to the world's largest collection of Azerbaijani carpets. The tour also includes a stop at Little Venice Park, where you'll feel like you're in a mini version of Italy. In the evening, take a leisurely walk along Baku's seaside to enjoy the spectacular views of Baku at night.



Day 03. From Baku to Gabala City

After breakfast, we will depart from Baku and head to Gabala, approximately 216 km from the capital. This tour is perfect for travelers eager to explore the beauty of the Caucasus Mountains, breathe fresh mountain air, and enjoy the natural landscapes. Gabala, one of the most ancient and beautiful cities in Azerbaijan, was the capital of Caucasian Albania for 600 years. On the way to Gabala, you will also have the opportunity to visit historical sites in Shamakhi, including the Juma Mosque.

Day 04. Gabala City Tour

After breakfast at the hotel, you will experience a breathtaking cable car ride up the green mountains, offering stunning views. Adventure lovers can also enjoy a thrilling ride on quad bikes (Quad Tour). Whether with friends or family, the exciting Gabala cable car experience and the panoramic views of the mountains—green in summer and snow-covered in winter—are unforgettable. Next, we will visit Lake Nohur, situated at the foot of the Caucasus Mountains, surrounded by forested slopes that change beautifully with each season. Boat rentals are available, and you can also enjoy fishing. The trip continues to the “Yeddi Gozel” waterfall, which flows from the highest peaks of the Caucasus Mountains. At the top of the waterfall, there's a traditional teahouse with a special wooden floor where you can relax, sip tea, and take in the soothing sounds of the



waterfall. The tour ends with a visit to Gabaland Entertainment Park, filled with exciting amusement rides and events for both children and adults.

Day 05. Guba – Baku

After breakfast at the hotel, we will transfer you back to Baku (about 168 km/2-3 hours). After checking into your hotel in Baku, you will have free time to rest.

Day 06. Absheron Tour

After breakfast at the hotel, we'll visit the Heydar Aliyev Center, an iconic cultural center designed in 2012 by Iraqi architect Zaha Hadid. We will then explore the Absheron Peninsula, located 20 km from Baku, where you will witness Yanar Dag (Mountain of Fire), a natural gas fire that has been burning for centuries and was considered sacred by ancient fire worshippers. Next, we'll visit Ateshgah, the Fire Temple, built by Indian merchants in the 17th and 18th centuries. The temple is rooted in the ancient fire-worshipping religions of Azerbaijan.

Day 07. Departure

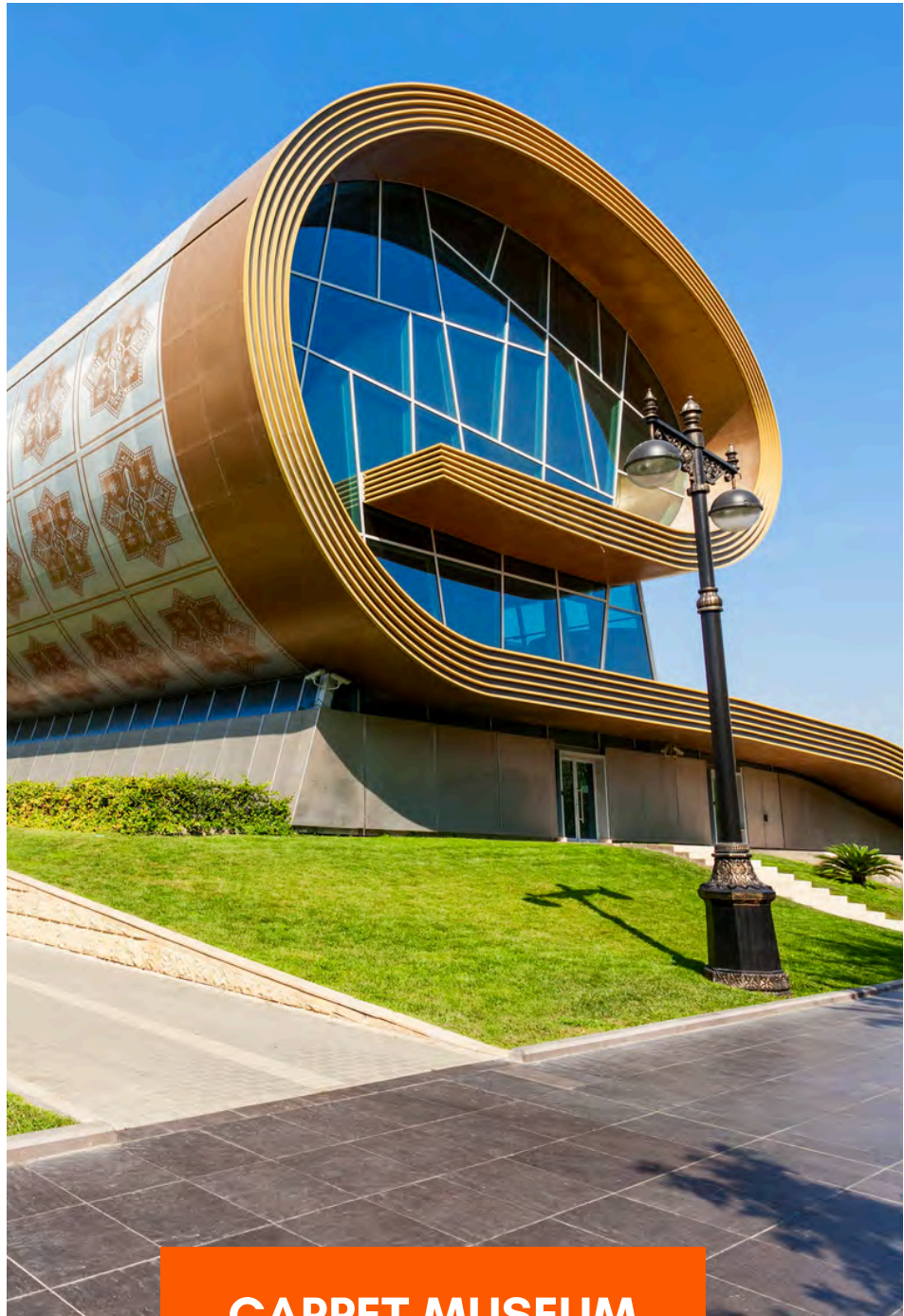

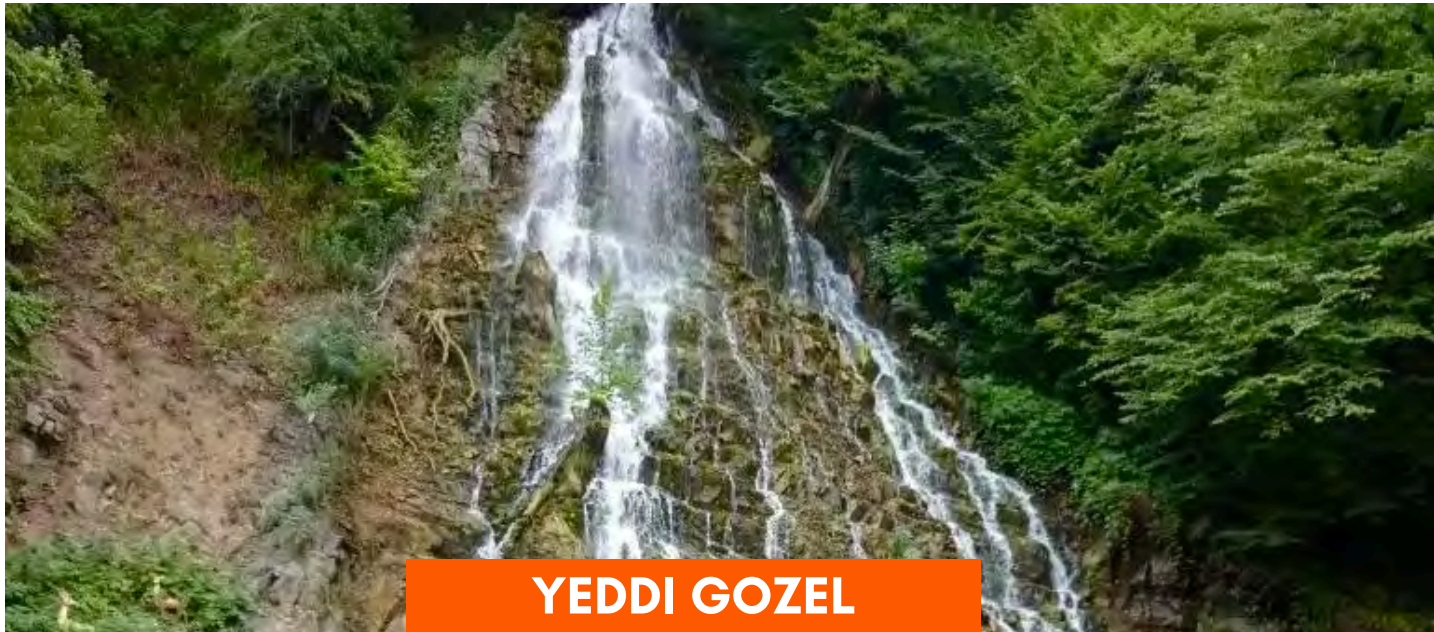

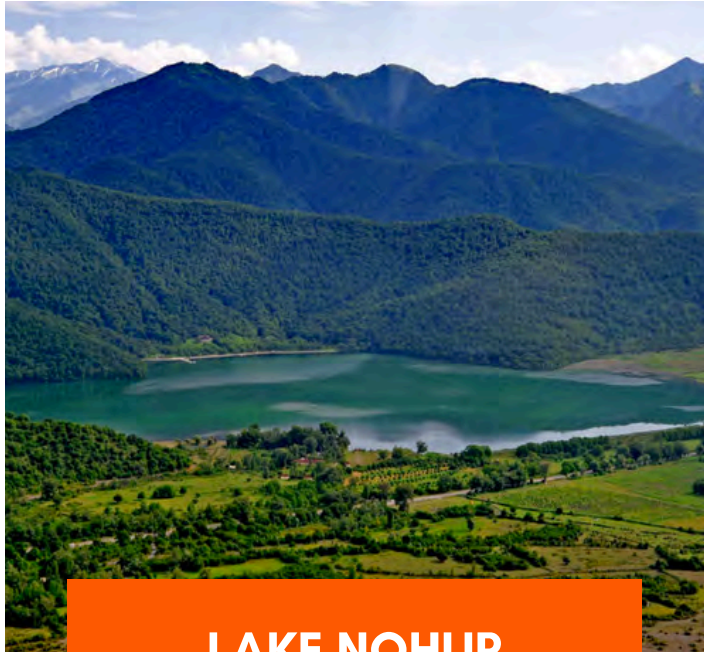
