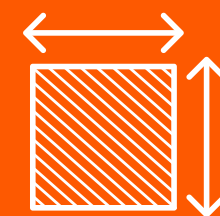

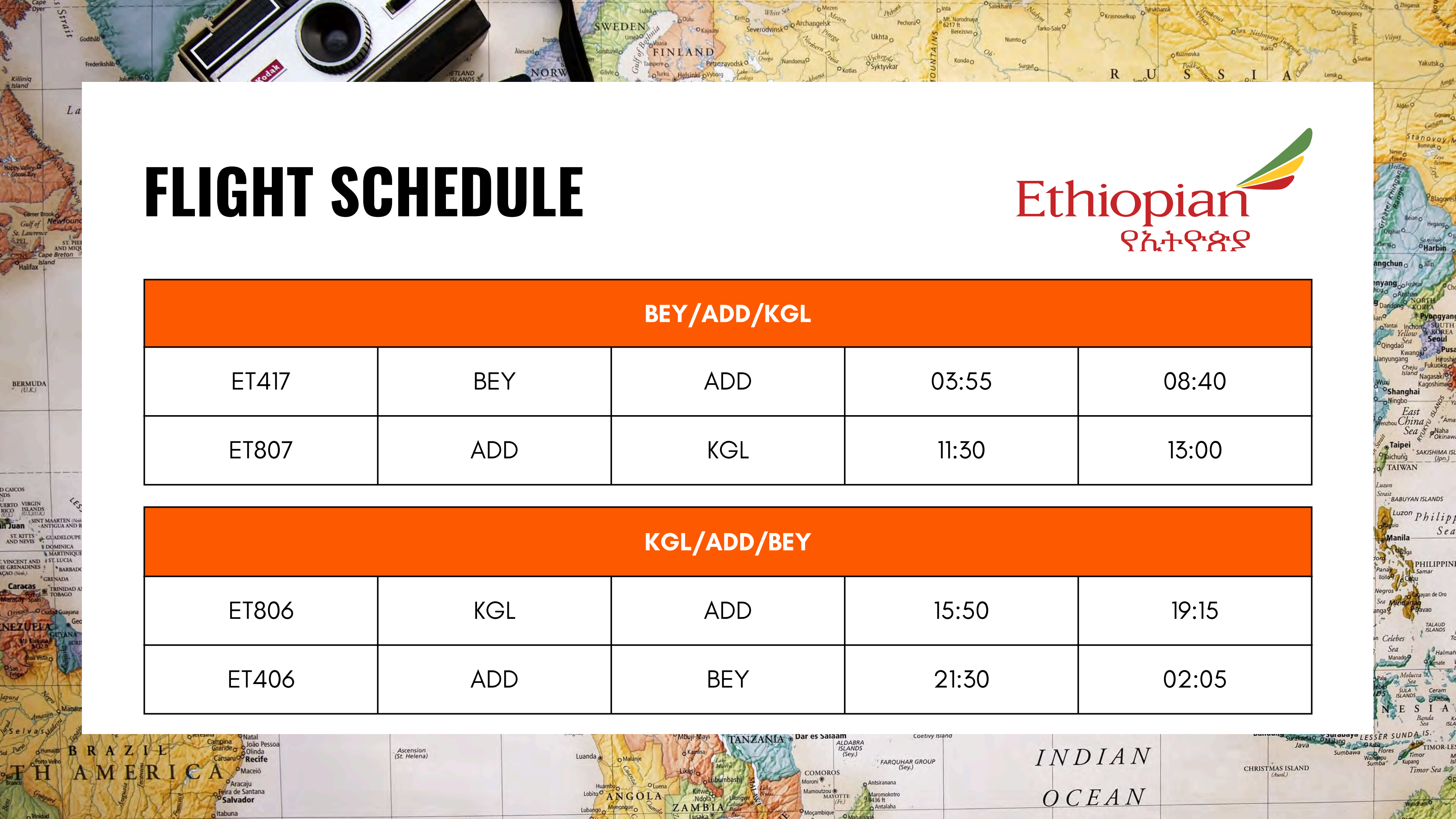

ITINERARY

Day 01. Arrival

Welcome to the Land of a Thousand Hills. Upon arrival at Kigali International Airport, you will be welcomed by one of our experienced safari guides who will transfer you to your hotel for the rest of the day and overnight. At check-in, you will be briefed about your safari and what to expect, including the safari do's and don'ts. Overnight at your hotel.

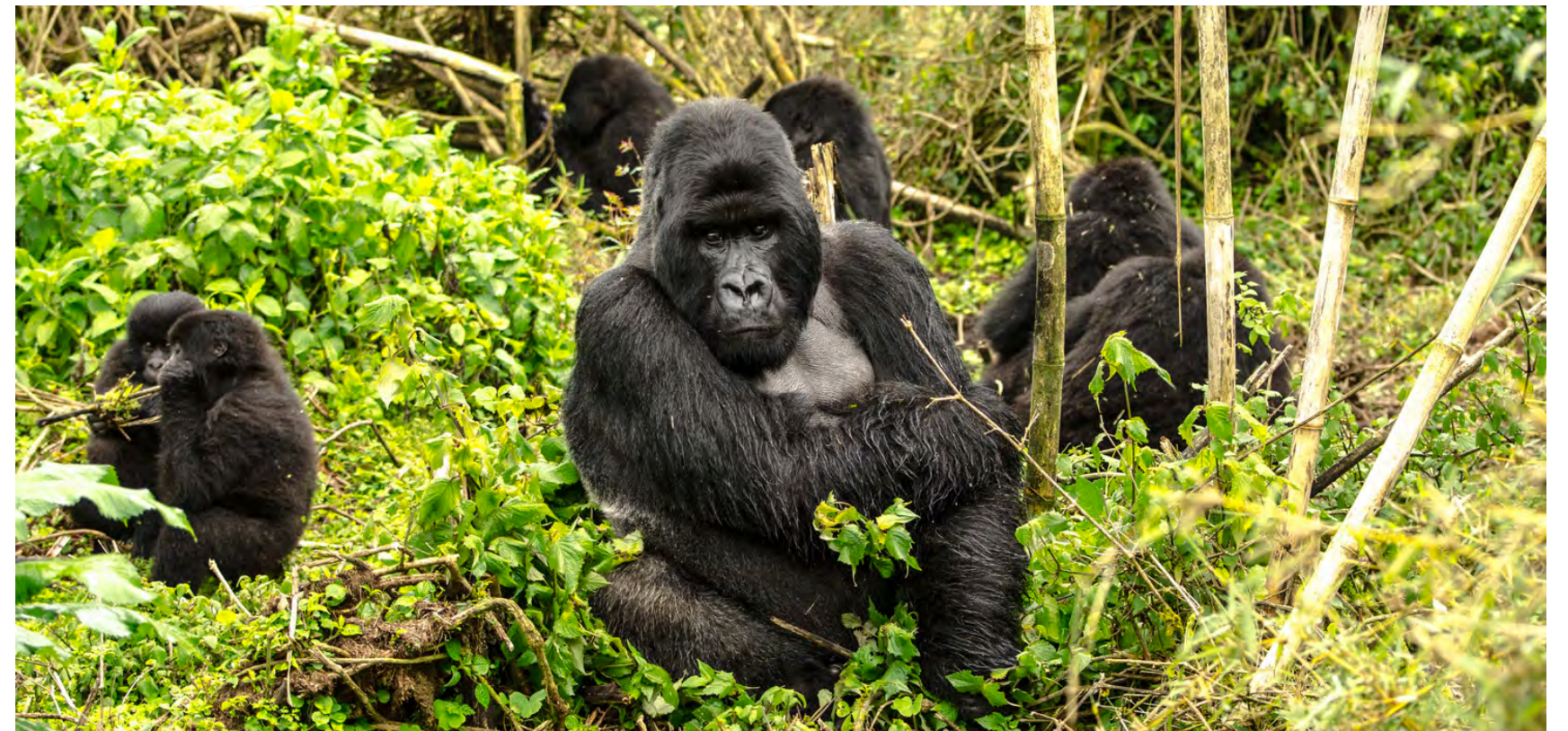
Day 02. Kigali City Tour & Transfer To Volcanoes National Park

After breakfast, you will be picked up from your hotel for a half-day Kigali city tour. The tour includes a visit to the Kigali Genocide Memorial and Museum to learn more about the 1994 genocide, as well as visits to local markets and more. Later, enjoy lunch before departing for Volcanoes National Park. The journey offers stunning views of the mountainous and green countryside, from which Rwanda gets its name, "The Land of a Thousand Hills." Dinner and overnight at your lodge.



Day 03. Gorilla Trekking In Rwanda & Community Walk

After breakfast, you will be transferred from your lodge to the park headquarters for a briefing on the day's Gorilla trekking activity. It is recommended to pack lunch, carry drinking water, and hire porters, as the time spent in the jungle is unpredictable. After the briefing from the park rangers, you will be assigned a Gorilla family and begin your trek through the forest in search of these gentle giants. Tracking the Gorillas can take anywhere from a few hours to a full day, depending on where they were last seen the previous night. Physical fitness is highly recommended, but those less able can opt for the "Human Helicopter" (Sedan chair). Upon locating the Gorillas, you will be allowed to spend a maximum of one hour with them, capturing videos and photographs. Afterward, return to your lodge for lunch. In the afternoon, enjoy a community walk to Red Rock, a local initiative aimed at improving community livelihood through environmental conservation, arts and culture, education, and community health and security. Overnight at your lodge.



Day 04. Transfer To Nyungwe Forest

National Park

After breakfast, embark on your 6–7 hour drive to Nyungwe Forest National Park, one of the oldest and largest rainforests in East Africa. The forest is renowned for its rich biodiversity, including a small population of chimpanzees and 12 other primate species, such as the L'Hoest's monkey, which is endemic to the Albertine Rift. Overnight at your lodge.

Day 05. Chimpanzee Tracking & Canopy

Walk

Early in the morning, set out for the renowned chimpanzee trekking in Nyungwe Forest National Park. This activity will take you deep into the jungle in search of chimpanzees, our closest primate relatives. It is recommended to pack your breakfast from the lodge, as the briefing starts as early as 5:30 a.m., with the trek beginning at 6:00 a.m. You will receive a briefing on park etiquette and guidelines from your ranger guide before starting your trek from either the Uwinka trailhead or the Cyamudongo sector.

Nyungwe is home to over 13 primate species, including chimpanzees, L'Hoest's monkeys, Rwenzori colobus monkeys, red-tailed monkeys, vervet monkeys, and grey-cheeked mangabeys. After lunch at the lodge, embark on the famous Canopy Walk, where you will explore



Nyungwe National Park 40 meters above ground level. Dinner and overnight at your lodge.

Day 06. Departure

Enjoy breakfast at your leisure before embarking on your 4-5 hour journey back to Kigali. Along the way, make a stop in Huye, formerly known as Butare, which hosts the Ethnographic Museum of Rwanda (formerly the National Museum of Rwanda). Here, you will gain insights into Rwandan culture, history, and daily life. Continue your journey to Kigali, arriving in the afternoon to connect with your international flight.
