ITINERARY

Day 01. Arrival

Upon arrival in Kathmandu, after clearing immigration and customs, you will be welcomed by our Nepal representative in the receiving area. Transfer to the hotel for check-in and enjoy a restful evening.


Day 02. Fly to Pokhara

The day begins with breakfast at 8:30 AM, followed by a drive to the domestic airport in Kathmandu for your flight to Pokhara. This picturesque city, known as the "City of Lakes," is a gateway to the majestic Himalayas, renowned for its scenic landscapes, tranquil lakes, and stunning mountain views. Upon arrival, enjoy a half-day sightseeing tour, where you will visit the International Mountain Museum, which offers insights into mountain culture, history, and the Himalayas. The tour continues to Bindabasini Temple, a sacred hilltop site dedicated to the goddess Bindhyabasini, blending spiritual significance with breathtaking views. Afterward, return to your hotel and enjoy the serene ambiance of Pokhara.

Day 03. Sightseeing in Pokhara

Begin the day early, around 5:30 AM, with a drive to Sarangkot Hill Station to witness the golden hues of sunrise illuminating the snow-





capped peaks of Dhaulagiri, Annapurna, Fishtail, and more. Alternatively, you can opt for a sunset visit for equally stunning vistas. After soaking in the views and capturing unforgettable photographs, return to your hotel for breakfast and a brief rest. Later, continue exploring Pokhara with a serene boat ride on Fewa Lake, followed by visits to the Pumdi Kot Shiva Statue, Davis Falls, and the sacred Mahadev Cave. Each site offers a unique perspective on Pokhara's natural beauty and cultural heritage.

Day 04. Fly Back to Kathmandu

After breakfast, fly back to Kathmandu to explore the city's rich cultural and historical landmarks. Visit the Boudhanath Stupa, one of the largest and most ancient Buddhist stupas in the world, and immerse yourself in its tranquil atmosphere. Continue to Patan Durbar Square, where the ancient Royal Palace and intricate Newari architecture captivate visitors. The journey through history continues at Kathmandu Durbar Square, the heart of the city's old royal ceremonies and traditional architecture. Conclude the day with free time in Thamel, a lively area filled with shops, restaurants, and trekking gear stores. Stroll through its bustling streets, interact with friendly locals, and shop for unique souvenirs to take home.

Day 05. Departure

Enjoy breakfast before your transfer, leaving with unforgettable memories of Nepal.
