



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



ITINERARY

Day 01. Arrival

Arrival in Sri Lanka. Welcome by our representative and transfer to Kandy en route to visit Pinnawala Elephant Orphanage. Providing a caring home for abandoned and wounded elephants, it is a much-loved destination for tourists and locals alike. Here, adults and baby elephants from around Sri Lanka thrive, and a captive breeding program is also proving to be highly successful. The feeding and bathing times are generally the ideal times to visit, when you can observe these gentle giants at their best.

Thereafter, visit the Spice Garden in Mawanella and Gem Gallery in Kandy. Check-in to the hotel and relax.

Evening: Round off your day with a Cultural Dance show, where the vibrant costumes and pulsating rhythms of traditional dance forms from centuries-old rituals will enthrall you.

Dinner and overnight stay in Kandy.

Day 02. Kandy – Nuwara Eliya

After breakfast, enjoy a city tour of Kandy – the last kingdom of the Sinhalese. Take in the sights of Upper Lake Drive and the Market Square on the way to pay homage to one of the most sacred





religious sites in Sri Lanka, the Temple of the Tooth (Dalada Maligawa), believed to house the 'tooth relic' of Lord Buddha. A walk around the town will let you indulge in some souvenir hunting with intricate treasures in wood, copper, silver, brass, ebony, bronze, ceramics, lacquer work, handlooms, batiks, jewelry, and reed-ware to choose from.

Thereafter, head 'up country' to the city of Nuwara Eliya, visiting Ramboda Waterfalls, Sri Bhakta Hanuman Temple, and a tea factory along the way.

The old colonial outpost, still referred to as 'Little England,' lives up to its name. Perched 6,200 feet above sea level, the climate adds to the illusion of stepping into an old English town, where neat hedges, quaint cottages, and beautiful old buildings stand serene as they did over a century ago. The magnificent Grand Hotel presides over them all. There is also an old golf course and horse racing events to complete the picture.

Check-in to the hotel and relax.


Dinner and overnight stay in Nuwara Eliya.

Day 03. Nuwara Eliya - Ella - Yala

After breakfast, proceed to Yala via Ella.

In Ella: Visit the 9 Arch Bridge, Ravana Falls, and Ravana Cave. Ella is a quiet hill-country town that draws visitors with its cool climate and picturesque setting deep in the heart of the 'up country.'





Steeped in the ancient legend of Rama and Sita from the Indian epic, the Ramayana, most significant natural landmarks are named after King Ravana – the local god who kidnapped the princess. The myriad locations connected to the legend are worth visiting, and the cascading Ravana Ella waterfall is breathtaking. The towering Ella Rock presides over the area, and Ella Gap offers spectacular views across distant valleys to the South Coast.

Check-in to the hotel and relax.

Dinner and overnight stay in Yala.

Day 04. Yala - Bentota

Morning: Embark on a morning safari at Yala National Park (5:30 – 9:30 AM). Yala National Park is the most visited and second-largest national park in Sri Lanka. It consists of five blocks, two of which are open to the public. Hugging the panoramic Indian Ocean, Yala was designated a wildlife sanctuary in 1900 and a national park in 1938. It was initially used as a hunting ground for the elite under British rule. Yala is home to 44 varieties of mammals and 215 bird species, including the world's largest concentration of leopards.

Return to the hotel for breakfast. Thereafter, proceed to Bentota via Galle.

In Galle: Visit the heritage city of Galle. For centuries, Galle has stood strong against invasions from colonial powers and nature's volatile outbursts. The famous Dutch Fort was first built by the





Portuguese, fortified by the Dutch, and preserved by the British. Despite over 400 years of ocean battering and surviving a tsunami, it is still enjoyed by residents and visitors today.

Check-in to the hotel and relax.

Dinner and overnight stay in Bentota.

Day 05. Bentota City Tour

After breakfast, enjoy a city tour of Bentota.

Located on Sri Lanka's South Coast, Bentota is an area interesting for bird watchers. The shore harbors sea birds and wanderers, including the rare Indian Heron, while vegetation along the river hosts many local species as well as winter migrants. Sightseeing tours include the Turtle Hatchery and Madu River boat rides. Madhu River Boat Ride: The biodiversity of the Madu River is significant, hosting a variety of aquatic and avian life as well as wetland-dwelling amphibians, reptiles, and mammals. The area is home to 70 fish species, 31 reptile types, and 50 butterfly species, alongside 111 bird species, including migratory birds.

Turtle Hatchery at Kosgoda: A successful conservation effort established to protect Sri Lanka's turtles from extinction.

Dinner and overnight stay in Bentota.

Day 06. Bentota - Colombo

After breakfast, transfer to Colombo and enjoy a city tour. Colombo, Sri Lanka's former capital, is the largest metropolis in the





country and remains its commercial and entertainment hub. It features corporate buildings, restaurants, shopping malls, spas, hotels, and nightclubs. Tree-lined streets add to its tropical charm, while the Viharamahadevi Park provides a lush retreat. Sit at an open terrace in the evening to watch stunning sunsets over the Indian Ocean.

Enjoy shopping in Colombo, with options ranging from local bazaars like Pettah to shopping malls like Majestic City and Liberty Plaza. Tourists also frequent ODEL and Arpico Supercenters for quality goods.

Check-in to the hotel and relax.

Dinner and overnight stay in Colombo.

Day 07. Departure


After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your flight back home, accompanied by happy memories of the tropical isle of Sri Lanka, once known as Taprobane.






















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
