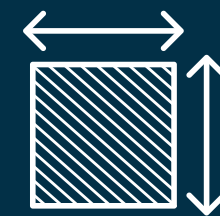

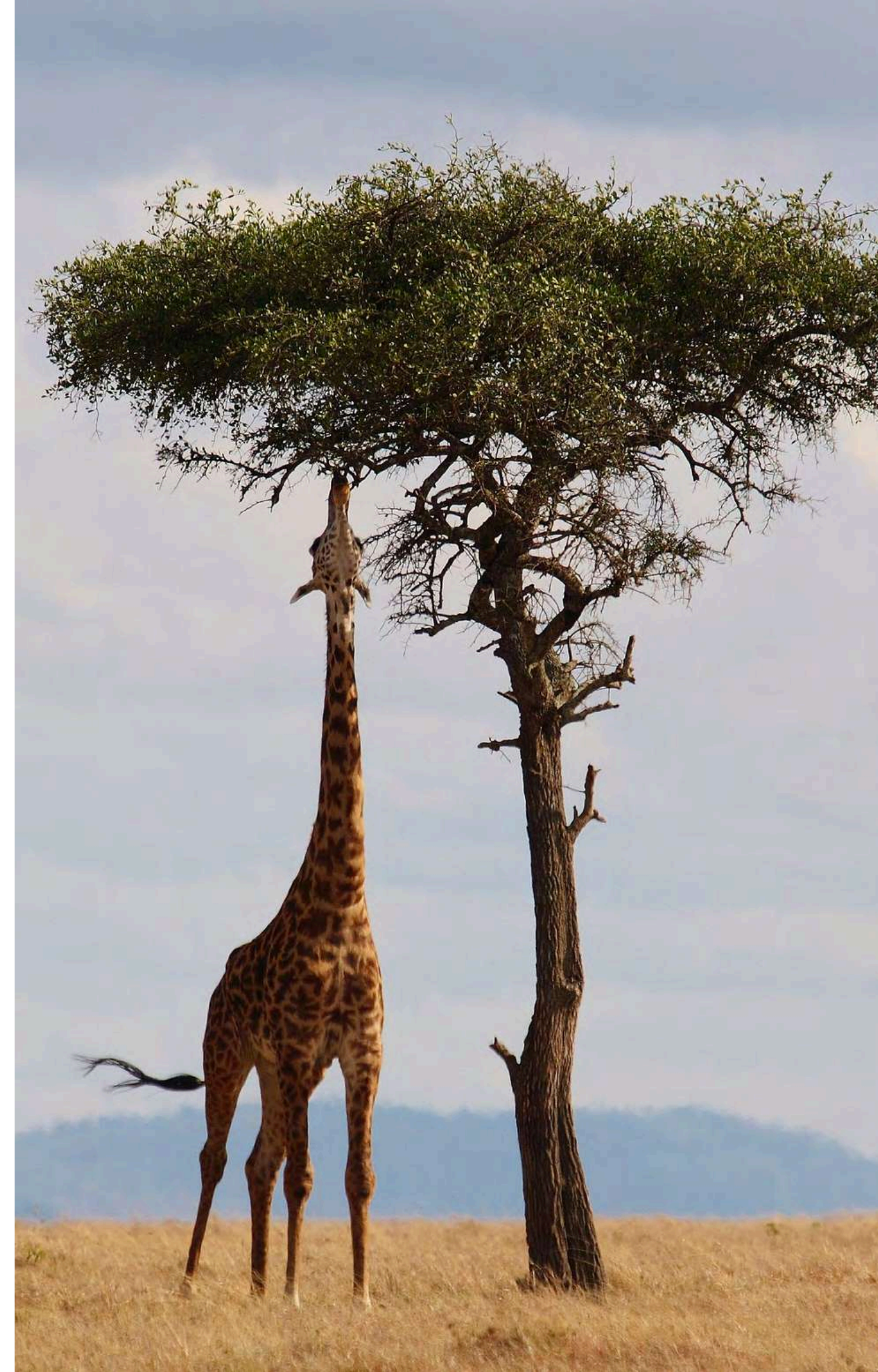

# ITINERARY

## Day 01. Arrival

Arrival to Nairobi, you will be picked from the airport (JKIA) and taken directly to your hotel for check in and thereafter lunch in Lake Nakuru, with a brief enroute stop over at the Rift valley view point. This shallow Soda Lake has been famous for its flamingos but has also retained its reputation as an ornithologists' delight with more than 400 species of bird found here. You may get out of the vehicle at the lake shore to get a closer look at the birds. The nearby cliffs offer sightings of baboons, birds of prey and scurrying hyraxes, as well as great views of the park. The national park covers 180 sq km and is home to warthogs, waterbuck, buffaloes, reedbucks, and the occasional leopard as well as white and black rhinos which were introduced to the park some years ago. Later we will go to your lodge for the night in Nakuru.

In the late afternoon you will go for a game drive and later come back to the hotel for dinner.

## Day 02. Lake Nakuru – Maasai Mara

Pick up from your hotel after breakfast and we will depart for Mara National Park, check in at your hotel then in the late afternoon you will go on your first game drive at the Mara national park and later come back to the hotel for dinner.

## Day 03. Maasai Mara

On this day, you may choose to either have a full day Safari or half day safari. After breakfast, we carry packed lunches and set off to search for great predators and perhaps even cubs continue today during extensive game runs. On the plains are enormous herds of grazing animals plus the elusive Cheetah and leopard hiding amidst acacia boughs. During our stay, we also have an optional opportunity to visit a village of the Masai people to witness the singing and dancing that are part of their daily lives and sacred rituals. A glimpse into their homes and social structure is a poignant experience)

## Day 04. Maasai Mara – Naivasha

On this morning, after having breakfast, you will head to Lake Naivasha. A freshwater lake, Naivasha (meaning 'rough water') is





home to an incredible variety of bird species and there is a full effort to protect the wildlife although the lake suffered a lot in the past by tourism activities.

You will be dropped at the hotel for Lunch and enjoy the animals within the hotel. You will take a boat ride on Lake Naivasha and can opt to go explore crescent island (at an additional entry fee cost) or enjoy the lush green well-manicured lawns of your lodge teaming with animals.

## Day 05. Departure

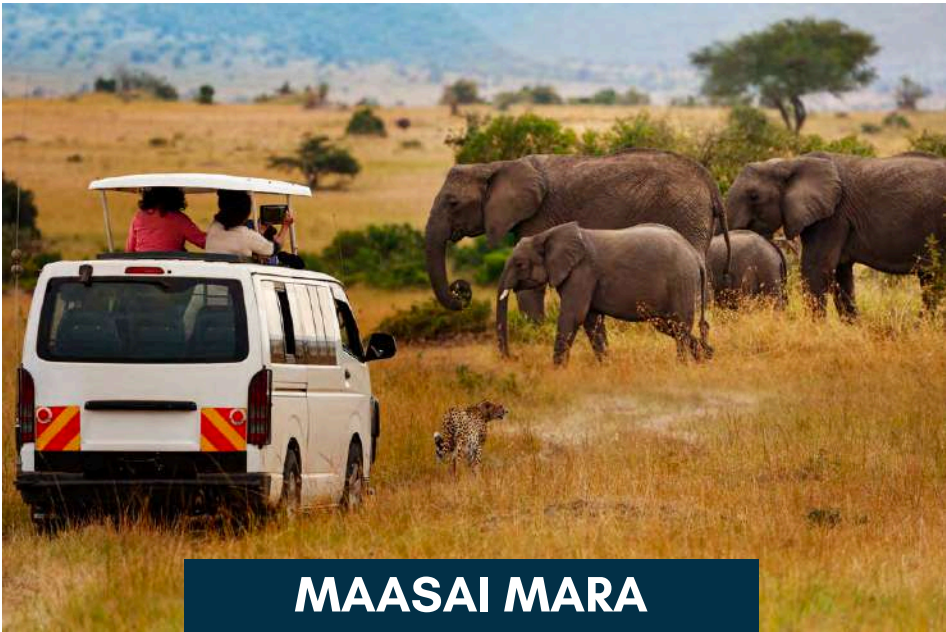
We will leave late morning after breakfast for your drive back to Nairobi, approximately one and a half hours away where you will be dropped back to your hotel/airport for departure.
